Barriere Lake Algonquins are facing political repression and 7 have been arrested on trumped up charges for their role in two peaceful blockades of highway 117. These blockades were a last resort for the community, who have been fighting for self-determination and sustainability in their territories for decades. Currently, they are demanding the federal and Quebec governments honor the Trilateral and other signed agreements and honor their traditional leadership selection process, which was intervened in by an Indian-affairs backed minority faction. As well, they are demanding an Algonquin language and culture program be instituted into the primary school curriculum, among other demands.
